Slavery: Human Trafficking In The United States

Learn to recognize and assist victims of human trafficking in the U.S.

Human trafficking, for sex and labor, is a reality in the United States. In this workshop participants will learn to recognize the signs of a trafficked person, and become familiar with national, state, and local resources for assisting victims.

Designed as a workshop presentation of 45 minutes or longer, depending on the size of the group.

Dr. Paula Trimble-Familetti is a passionate advocate for women's rights, inclusive language, and biblical literacy. She spent thirty years as an elementary school teacher, afraid to follow her call to write the stories of biblical women, to advocate for women, and to further biblical literacy. She holds a B.A. in Religion from Chapman University, an M.A. in Religion from Liberty University, and a Doctor of Ministry in International Feminist Theology from San Francisco Theological Seminary. Paula taught Women and Religion and Women's History classes for Chapman University and is past co-convener of the Women's Caucus of the American Academy of Religion. She is a regular contributor to the Words of Faith column in the *Desert Sun News*. Her first book, *Prostitutes, Virgins, and Mothers: Questioning Teachings About Biblical Women*, won a gold medal in Bible study from Illumination Book Awards.
